Acetaminophen (Tylenol)

Tylenol can be given every <u>4-6 hours</u> as needed for fever greater than or equal to 100.4 degrees. <u>Do not</u> give Acetaminophen to infants younger than 8 weeks old without consulting your pediatrician.

Ibuprofen (Motrin, Advil)

Ibuprofen can be given every <u>6-8 hours</u> as needed for fever greater than or equal to 100.4 degrees. <u>Do not</u> use in infants below 6 months of age or less than 16 lbs without consulting your pediatrician.
